Rules of the competition for the best individual thematic collection of minerals during the 27th Lwówek Agate Summer

Lwówek Śląski, July 10-12, 2026

§1

The competition is organized by the Lwówek Śląski Cultural Center, located at ul. Przyjaciół Żołnierza 5, 59-600 Lwówek Śląski - co-organizer of the 27th Lwówek Śląski Agate Summer.

§2

1. The competition aims to identify the best individual mineralogical collections in terms of their merit.
2. Only exhibitions by individual collectors, with specimens not intended for sale, presented in exhibition spaces designated by the competition organizer, are eligible for participation.
3. Exhibitions organized by state institutions (museums, etc.) are not eligible for participation in the competition.
4. Applications for exhibitions must be submitted no later than May 31, 2026, to the following address: Lwówek Śląski Organizational Office, ul. Przyjaciół Żołnierza, Lwówek Śląski. Przyjaciół Żołnierza 5, 59-600 Lwówek Śląski, email: lok@lwowekslaski.pl.
5. Entries must include a substantive description of the exhibition (with attached photographic documentation) and the desired exhibition space (min. 1.5 m² - 1 display case, 3 shelves, max. 3.0 m² - 2 display cases, 6 shelves).
6. The size of the rented space is not a criterion for subsequent exhibition evaluation.
7. The Organizer has a limited exhibition space (max. 24 display cases).
8. Display cases placed in the Municipal Hall are of equal rank and will be awarded by drawing lots.
9. In the event of a large number of entries, the Competition Organizer reserves the right to select the exhibition based on the materials provided by the entrants, in consultation with the Competition Committee. The Competition Organizer will notify applicants whether or not an exhibition has been accepted for exhibition by June 15, 2026.

§3

1. The competition exhibition will take place in the Municipal Hall of the Lwówek Śląski Town Hall (ground floor).
2. Installation of exhibitions accepted for exhibition is possible from July 6-8, from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM, or on July 9, from 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM.
3. Exhibitions presented by foreign exhibitors should be described in Polish or both Polish and English.
4. Exhibitions should not contain information about the name and surname of the author/owner or elements identifying the exhibition with the author/owner.

§4

1. The awards will be granted by an independent committee appointed by the organizer, consisting of academics from universities and experts in mineralogy and museology. The committee was appointed by order of the Director of the Lwówek Cultural Center by May 15, 2026.
2. During the evaluation, exhibitions/collections will be identified by their number and title/name. They will not be identified by the name of the author/owner. If the exhibitions contain elements described in §3, point 4, these elements will remain covered during the evaluation.
3. 1st-3rd places are awarded in one category: Minerals - Thematic Collection.
4. During the exhibition evaluation, the committee awards points. The evaluation of the exhibition will be based on: quality and selection of specimens (maximum 10 points), substantive development (maximum 10 points), and graphic and artistic presentation (maximum 10 points).
5. The Competition Jury will award financial prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place, as well as participation prizes. The Jury may not award the main prizes or award two equal prizes. The amount of the prizes depends on the funds allocated by the Organizer in a given year.

Main Prize - PLN 8,000;

Honorable Mention - PLN 4,000;

Audience Prize - PLN 4,000;

Participation Prize - PLN 1,000.

Pursuant to Article 30, Section 1, Item 2 of the Personal Income Tax Act of July 26, 1991 (Journal of Laws 2025, item 163, consolidated text), the Competition Organizer will pay income tax at a rate of 10%.

6. The results will be announced and the awards ceremony will take place on Saturday, July 11, 2026, on the main stage of the LLA (town square in Lwówek Śląski) at approximately 4:00 PM.
7. Competition exhibitions may be dismantled on Sunday, July 12th, from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM, or the following day. Collections may be displayed in a display case after the LLA has concluded, subject to prior arrangement with the organizer. In such a case, the exhibit owner consents in writing to the Organizer relocating the exhibits to the display case(s) on the first floor of the Town Hall.

§5

1. The personal data of competition participants will be processed solely for purposes related to the Competition, i.e., its organization and conduct. Participants have the right to access their personal data, correct it, request its deletion, and object to its processing.

2. The competition organizer reserves the right to take photographic documentation of the exhibitions and use the obtained materials in publications, publications, advertising presentations, and all promotional activities.
